SWITCH YOUTH MOVIE WORLD INFORMATION

Below is some helpful information for you.

Buses

Arrive at 8am for sign in out the front of the A1 Auditorium (where we normally sign in for youth).

Buses will depart Bridgeman at 8.30am.

What to Bring

We encourage youth to bring a hat, sunscreen and a water bottle to Movie World. Switch Youth will provide some sunscreen for those in need.

Storage of Belongings

There is limited storage for belongings at Movie World. We encourage all youth to minimise the number of belongings they bring on the trip, limiting unnecessary valuable items and large bags.

Meeting Point

On arrival, our leaders will escort the youth to the group meeting area. Leaders will be stationed at the group meeting area throughout the duration of the trip to ensure there is always a familiar and friendly face on hand to help any youth who requires assistance.

Food / Money

There will be a range of food available for purchase at Movie World. We will not be providing any food as part of the trip so encourage you to bring money to purchase lunch and snacks.

Supervision

Prior to the youth exploring the park, our leaders will speak with the youth regarding safety information, first aid etc. Youth are then welcome to pair up with their friends and leaders when exploring the park.

Our leadership team will be on hand to help provide general support and supervision in addition to the Movie World staff.
