Pre-marriage Course Outline 2019

This course is particularly suitable to engaged couples and couples who may be considering the possibility of marriage and would value the information prior to a possible formal commitment.

Objectives:

That couples will:

- Develop realistic expectations about marriage
- Be encouraged to develop a biblical perspective about marriage
- Explore significant practical and relational issues that often confront couples entering into marriage
- Review their relationship in the light of the course helping them to make wise decisions about whether their relationship should proceed to marriage.

Course dates: Five Sunday afternoons 2:30pm-4pm Oct 20th, 27th & Nov 3rd, 10th – NB. The fifth session is still to be confirmed.

Following the Course: Organising the Wedding (by arrangement)

Intention of Marriage Form

- Couples to complete Intention of Marriage Form (legal requirement)
- Receive "Happily Ever Before & After" pamphlet (legal requirement)

Completion of "Prepare" Inventory

- A "Prepare" Inventory is completed by the couple which is analysed by the Prepare professional team in Sydney with suggested areas to consider for the future. ('Prepare' cost \$44 per couple)
- The results of the analysis will be discussed with the couple by the Pastor.
